

Checklist for a perfect trip to Uganda!

- ☐ Mosquito net (always use it at night, even if the locals are confident without it)
- ☐ Soap (to wash your clothes)
- ☐ Short (+long) clothing → different to other sources, it doesn't seem to be a problem to wear long clothes in public, apart from visiting the church
- ☐ Cable tie (i.e. for hanging up the mosquito net)
- ☐ Fanny pack (*Bauchtasche*) = protects against robberies
- ☐ Disinfection wipes (often no fluent water and those can be helpful for getting rid of soap remains, especially when you need to put in contact lenses)
- ☐ Flip Flops (easy to wash, especially with the clay soil/*Lehmboden*)
- ☐ Creditcard (At many airports you can even use your EC card)
- ☐ Presents for the locals (See below)
- ☐ Clothesline + brackets
- ☐ Laptop
- ☐ Pepper spray
- ☐ Charging cable, power banks
- ☐ Raining jacket
- ☐ Headphones
- ☐ Knife
- ☐ Fenistil
- ☐ Carabiner hooks
- ☐ Mosquito spray
- ☐ First-aid kit (plasters)
- ☐ Spoon
- ☐ Shampoo
- ☐ Sunscreen
- ☐ Oropax
- ☐ Vaccination pass + copy
- ☐ Passport + copy (needs to be valid for at least six months at the point of entry)
- ☐ Hiking shoes
- ☐ Sunglasses
