

## **Checklist for a perfect trip to Uganda!**

Mosquito net (always use it at night, even if the locals are confident without it)
Soap (to wash your clothes)
Short (+long) clothing $\Rightarrow$ different to other sources, it doesn't seem to be a problem
to wear long clothes in public, apart from visiting the church
Cable tie (i.e. for hanging up the mosquito net)
Fanny pack (Bauchtasche) = protects against robberies
Disinfection wipes (often no fluent water and those can be helpful for getting rid of
soap remains, especially when you need to put in contact lenses)
Flip Flops (easy to wash, especially with the clay soil/Lehmboden)
Creditcard (At many airports you can even use your EC card)
Presents for the locals (See below)
Clothesline + brackets
Laptop
Pepper spray
Charging cable, power banks
Raining jacket
Headphones
Knife
Fenistil
Carabiner hooks
Mosquito spray
First-aid kit (plasters)
Spoon
Shampoo
Sunscreen
Oropax
Vaccination pass + copy
Passport + copy (needs to be valid for at least six months at the point of entry)
Hiking shoes
Sunglasses
Daypack
